arranged for Thursday 15th January. start collecting any items you may wish to donate.


Bags will be coming home soon, and we will text to remind you of the collection nearer the date.

We are once again experiencing a high volume of lost property. Please ensure that all items of clothing (uniform, PE kit, foot wear etc) are clearly named. We do hold a 'lost property amnesty' at the end of every term, when you are invited in to school to investigate if any items belong to your child/ren. We are hoping that, with your help, the amount of lost property will decrease to such an extent that this amnesty will not be necessary. Thank you for your support.

Parking Outside of School

The road outside school is always very busy at the beginning and end of the school day. It is also particularly busy when we have an event in school, such as parent assemblies and concerts. Our local Council and the police are concerned about inconsiderate and dangerous parking (some of which could be considered



unlawful). We have again had complaints from local residents who have not been able to get out of their drives because of parked cars. Residents have informed us that they will be recording and reporting registration plates. The police will issue tickets to drivers they find parking inappropriately or stopping on the zig-zag lines at the school entrance.
