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# Absences, Appointments and Early/Late Arrivals

Could we please ask that you inform the school office as soon as possible during the first morning of absence if your child is going to be off school. Until we have received a reason for such an absence the register will automatically record an 'Unauthorised Absence'. It is also necessary for you to confirm in writing, when your child returns to school, the reason for absence. Please also notify us in advance in writing if it is necessary to take your child out of school for an appointment.

Can we also request that every effort is made to ensure your child arrives at school promptly for a 8.50am start. In the event that this is not possible, please inform the school office. After registers close a late unauthorised absence (coded 'O' on your child's attendance register) will be recorded.

We have had several instances recently when children have arrived for school before 8.30am. There will be no staff available for supervision at this time. In the interests of child safety we would be grateful if you could ensure that your child does not arrive on school premises before 8.45am.

If you have any concerns that you wish to address with your child's teacher, please do not hesitate to make an appointment. Thank you for your continued support.
